PACKED LUNCH GUIDELINES

We aim to promote healthy eating habits and encourage children to enjoy a variety of nutritious foods

Packed Lunch Ideas

Main Options:

- Whole-grain sandwiches, wraps, or pitta bread with fillings like lean chicken, tuna, cheese, or hummus.
- Pasta or rice salads with vegetables and a protein source.

NUT-FREE POLICY

- Please remember that we are a nut-free nursery due to allergy concerns.
- Ensure that all packed lunch items do not contain nuts or traces of nuts, including spreads like peanut butter or Nutella.

WHAT TO AVOID

- High-sugar snacks (e.g., chocolate bars, sweets, or sugary biscuits).
- Fizzy drinks or juice with added sugar.
- Foods high in salt or saturated fat (e.g., chips or processed meats).

MEDICATION & ILLNESS POLICY

- **Prescribed Medication Only:** The medication must be in its original packaging, clearly labelled with the child's name and dosage instructions from a physician.
- **Medication Form:** A medication consent form must be completed and signed before any medicine can be given to your child.
